Frontier has deployed or plans to deploy its fiber-to-the-premises network in this wire center and intends to provide services over a fiber network infrastructure. Existing customers on copper facilities will be migrated to the new fiber network infrastructure. Updating our network from copper to fiber benefits our customers because of fiber's resiliency and reliability, especially in inclement weather. Fiber also provides our customers with expanded capabilities to grow with current bandwidth demands for their home or business.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

After implementation of this plan, copper facilities will no longer be available at the address locations attached to this notice. Currently all existing circuits will be transferred to the fiber platform once completed. The affected competitive carriers are being notified.

Frontier will: (1) no longer offer services over copper facilities; and (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities. To help ensure an orderly transition,

Frontier may require customers and interconnecting entities to migrate services off of copper well before the copper retirement implementation date.
