- Use the [Wholesale Broadband Ordering Scenario Matrix](#) to verify that your order *scenario* is valid

Reserve or Request a Phone Number

A telephone number may be reserved or requested for these order scenarios:

- DB/N for Standalone service
- DB/N or DB/C-V LNA N for a new Wholesale Advantage shared voice and WH BB service

To request a telephone number, place the value **N** in the ATN field of the LSR form and the TNS field on the PS Form.

OR

Submit a **Pre-Order Direct TN Selection Response TXTYP B** to reserve a number
The reserved TN is displayed in the TNRES field

TOS Values

DB Reqtype: Use the appropriate TOS value for your Reqtype DB order scenario. TOS values can be found in the LSR Validation Sheets or the *Wholesale Platform Ordering Combination* matrices on the [Wholesale Advantage Broadband](#) page of the Frontier Wholesale Operations Website.

EB Reqtype: Use the appropriate TOS value for your Reqtype EB-C LNA C order scenario using this chart

Basic Order Tips

- When ordering voice service at the same time as WABB (DB-N shared service), follow BAU procedures for ordering the voice line. Then add the WABB feature, term/offer, modem code and static IP block code, if applicable.
- When ordering WH BB service on an existing line (LNA C), populate the service specific form with the WABB feature, term/offer, modem code and static IP block code, if applicable.
- When ordering Standalone WABB, enter the reserved phone number or the value N in the TNS and ATN fields. Populate the WABB features, term/offer codes, and static IP block code, if applicable. When a modem is desired, include the lease or purchase S&E code.

Static IP Block Code	Conditional <ul style="list-style-type: none">When a static IP block of 5 usable addresses or larger is desired, enter the IP Block S&E code in a FEATURE field. (No code is required for 1 usable address.)
Term/Offer Code	Required Enter the term/offer S&E code. Options are M-t-M, 1 year, 2 year
Modem Code	Asymmetrical Products (Modem Required) <ul style="list-style-type: none">Enter the Modem S&E code for the modem that is suitable for the WABB product ordered. Leased or Purchased options are available.

LSR Remarks

When Static IP service is ordered, the LSR Remarks should contain the name, phone number, and email address of the technical contact. If not on the LSR, the PON Initiator will be contacted to provide technical information. Static IP blocks of 5 usable addresses and larger should include the intended usage of the Static IP addresses.
