Subject: Oscoda County, Michigan 9-1-1 Service Provider Change
Date Effective: Immediately

Frontier Communications is providing notification that Oscoda County 9-1-1 Michigan has changed their 9-1-1 Service Provider from Frontier Communications to Peninsula Fiber Network (PFN). Effective **July 31, 2019**, Frontier Communications will be discontinuing traffic for Oscoda County Michigan. On July 31, 2019, Oscoda County will no longer be on the Frontier 9-1-1 network. Consequentially, any 9-1-1 traffic currently being handled by Frontier's selective routers for Oscoda County MI, will be discontinued on the Frontier 9-1-1 network.

ILECs, CLECs, Wireless, and VoIP providers who require 9-1-1 service for their customers in Oscoda County Michigan must establish new 9-1-1 trunks to the PFN Selective Routers. Once new 9-1-1 trunks to PFN are turned up, disconnect requests of the existing 9-1-1 trunks should be submitted to Frontier.

The change impacts ILECs, CLECs, Wireless and VoIP providers connected to either of the following Selective Routers:

- ALMA DMS100 Selective Router: ALMAMIXG5ED (ESN's 185,186,186)
- Roscommon ECS1000 Selective Router: RSCMMIXH2ED (ESN's 175;176 177)
