Subject: FCC Tariff Modifications and Introducing the New Interstate Service Guide Webpage
Date Effective: 11/01/2018

Frontier has filed a [Transmittal No. 93](#) with the FCC, effective November 1, 2018.

With this filing, Frontier will:

- *Remove all packet-based business data services; circuit-based data services above the DS3 bandwidth level; DS1 and DS3 end user channel terminations, and all other tariffed special access services, in any market deemed competitive; DS1 and DS3 end user channel terminations and other special access services in a Serving Wire Center (SWC) for which the price cap local exchange carrier was granted Phase II pricing flexibility prior to June 2017.*
- *Add language to clarify that Pricing Flexibility left in the tariff is only applicable to switched access.*
- *Remove Busy Line Interrupt (BLI) and Busy Line Verification (BLV) services from its FCC Tariff No. 11 since they have been discontinued pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.71.*
- *Update tariff language dealing with additional labor on each tariff.*
