Wherever in the tariff the name Frontier Communications of the Carolinas Inc. or the term "Company" appears, that shall mean and shall refer to Frontier Communications of the Carolinas LLC. Areas served by the Company are designated on exchange maps filed with the North Carolina Utilities Commission. These areas encompass all North Carolina territories previously served by the former Contel of North Carolina, Inc. and the former General Telephone Company.

The Company has elected to have its rates, terms, and conditions for its services determined pursuant to North Carolina Statute §62-133.5(h). When services are not provided pursuant to this tariff, the rates, terms and conditions shall be offered pursuant to Frontier's Product Guide(s) which may be found at www.frontier.com.

All previous tariffs are hereby withdrawn.

Effective September 7, 2026 all services subject to this Tariff that are provided to any location in this state wholly or in part over copper facilities, other than for Lifeline-eligible customers, are no longer available for new purchase by any customers. Effective November 16th, 2026, all services subject to this Tariff that are provided to any location in this state wholly or in part over copper facilities, other than for Lifeline-eligible customers, are discontinued, subject to a reasonable period for existing customers to transition off the services.

EXPLANATION OF SYMBOLS
