Subject:	DEMARC Beyond MPOE on Switched Ethernet Services ASRs
Date Effective:	February 2, 2023

Effective February 2, 2023, we will no longer accept Switched Ethernet Services requests that direct Frontier to bill the end-user for placing the Demarcation Point (DEMARC) beyond the Minimum Point of Entry (MPOE).

The following General Exchange Tariff Options (GETO) field values are or will be prohibited for Switched Ethernet Services: A, B, D E, F, G, H, I, N, O, P, R, T, U, V, Y, and Z.

The GETO field on the Access Service Request (ASR) must be populated with 'W' to initiate the following requests:

- DEMARC beyond the MPOE (a.k.a. Network Interface Device [NID] Annexation)
- DEMARC Moves

The Carrier submitting the ASR will be billed all associated fees for placing the DEMARC beyond the MPOE when GETO value is populated with "W".
