**Description of Network Changes Planned:**

**CITIZENS TELECOM CA. DBA FRONTIER COM OF CA** – announces that it intends to retire its Stromberg Carlson DCO switch from the wire centers listed below:

On or after December 13, 2024, the Wilton, CA DCO switch and associated remotes, will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Codes (NXX) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 916 currently residing in the Wilton, CA DCO switch and associated remotes (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the EKGVCAXGPS3 PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).



**Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:**

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Wilton, CA DCO switch and associated remotes, will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Elk Grove, CA PEO switch. This will occur on or after December 13, 2024.

**Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:**

The Elk Grove, CA PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Wilton, CA DCO switch and associated remotes. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Elk Grove, CA Tandem (EKGVCA XG42T Intra-Lata SHA/ EKGVCA XG42T Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Wilton, CA DCO switch and remotes, it will be retired and removed from the network.



**Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):**

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Elk Grove Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Wilton, CA DCO switch and remotes, will be required to reposition the codes to the Elk Grove Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Elk Grove Tandem switch must be received no later than November 15, 2024, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by November 29, 2024. All ASRs for the Elk Grove Tandem switch must carry the project code of EKGVCAXHDS0.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Wilton, CA DCO switch and remotes.
