Wholesale Platform Overview – Connecticut

Overview

Wholesale Platform is a bundle of loop, switching, and enhanced features offered through a commercially negotiated agreement between Frontier Communications and a CLEC.

Requisition Type

Wholesale Platform ordering is submitted in Virtual Front Office (VFO) using the Requisition Type (REQTYP) DB

Daily Usage Files

The Daily Usage File (DUF) is an option by which Wholesale Platform CLECs can receive usage billing records for end-user accounts.

Daily Usage File (DUF) is a process in which a CLEC can receive its usage sensitive recordings in the industry standard Exchange Message Interface (EMI) format.

The recordings can be used to but are not limited to:
Billing end user
Report creation
Account investigation

Connecticut Wholesale Platform Limitations

Overview

Wholesale Platform is POTS service only. The loop portion is offered as a Basic Analog POTS non-designed loop.

Service
Limitations

Services that are not available with Wholesale Platform are as follows

- Calling cards
- Call discount plans
- Optional calling plans
- Centrex service
- Voicemail/Message Center
- Off premise extensions
(If an off premise extension is on the retail account, a separate order must be issued first to remove the off premise extension before migration)
- Remote call forwarding
- Foreign exchange service
- Gift billing
- ISDN BRI
- PBX
- DS1 service
- Handicapped services *including Lifeline
(these are handled by the CLEC for the End-User)
- Multi wire center requests
- DSL service

Note: The switch determines specific routing capability

Migration Order Limitations

Migration order activity prohibits the following changes on ACT=V LSR.

- Telephone number changes
- Final bill address changes
- Service address changes
- Re-grade from Business to Residence type of service
