Description of Network Changes Planned:

Frontier Communications of the Carolinas Inc. - SC announces that it intends to retire it's GTD-5 Host switch in the wire center listed below:

On or after November 15, 2025, the Lamar GTD-5 Host switch will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Code (NXX) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 843 currently residing in the Lamar GTD-5 Host switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the LAMRSCXARPO PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Lamar GTD-5 Host switch and associated remotes will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Myrtle Beach SC PEO switch. This will occur on or after November 15, 2025.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Myrtle Beach PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Lamar SC GTD-5 Host switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Myrtle Beach, SC Tandem (MYBHSCAF1GT Intra-Lata SHA/ MYBHSCAF1GT Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Lamar, SC Host switch, it will be retired and removed from the network.



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Myrtle Beach, SC Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Lamar SC Host switch will be required to reposition the codes to the MYBHSCAF1GT Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the MYBHSCAF1GT Tandem switch must be received no later than October 15, 2025, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by November 15, 2025. All ASRs for the MYBHSCAF1GT Tandem switch must carry the project code of **LAMRSCXA32E**.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Lamar SC Host switch.
