<b>Subject:</b>	Modifications to Ethernet Enabled SWC List
<b>Date Effective:</b>	June 30, 2025

This bulletin provides notice that Frontier has modified the Ethernet Enabled Serving Wire Center (SWC) List. The modifications to the List will become effective on June 30, 2025.

Notable changes to the Ethernet Enabled SWC List include the following:

1. E\_NNI\_Interconnect tab: Added a 100G ENNI column; if populated with “Y”, available on the HBE network.
2. Ethernet\_Enabled\_SWC tab:
  - a. Repurposed the “SPEED” column to “HBESpeed”, displaying the maximum speed available on the HBE network.
  - b. Created a new column: “LegacySpeed”, displaying the maximum speed available on the Legacy network.
  - c. Created a new column: “Epath X-Network”, which when populated with one of the three values, indicates Cross-Network availability:
    - i. Yes: Cross-Network is available.
    - ii. Extended Int.: Cross-Network is available with an additional 45 days added to the FOC interval.
    - iii. No: Cross-Network is unavailable.
