Description of Network Changes Planned:

Frontier Comm of WV announces that it intends to retire its Stromberg Carlson DCO switch from the wire center listed below:

Wire Center	Address	CLLI
Widen, WV	Rt 15/4 Widen WV	WIDNWVXARSO

On or after April 18, 2026, the Widen, WV DCO remote switch will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Code (NXX) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 304 currently residing in the Widen WV DCO remote switch and associated remotes (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the **Charleston WV** PEO Meta switch (see details in Table A below).

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Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Widen WV DCO remote switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Charleston, WV PEO switch. This will occur on or after April 18, 2026.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Charleston, WV PEO Meta switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrating from the Widen DCO switch and Associated remotes. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Charleston, WV Tandem (CHTNWVLE26T Intra-Lata SHA/ CHTNWVLE26T Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Widen, WV DCO remote, it will be retired and removed from the network.

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Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Charleston Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Widen, WV DCO switch, and remotes will be required to reposition the codes to the Charleston Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Charleston Tandem switch must be received no later than March 18, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by April 18, 2026. All ASRs for the Charleston Tandem switch must carry the project code of WIDNWVXARSO.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Widen WV DCO switch and remotes.
