Description of Network Changes Planned:

Frontier Communications of Nevada- announces that it intends to retire its DMS10 switch the wire centers listed below:

Wire Center	Address	CLLI

On or after April 30, 2026, the Wendover, NV DMS10 switch, will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

The Exchange Codes (NXX) 775 in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 664 currently residing in the Wendover, NV DMS10 switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the DELTUTXCPS0 PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Wendover, NV DMS10 switch, and associated remotes will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Delta, UT PEO switch. This will occur on or after April 30, 2026.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Delta, UT PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Wendover, NV DMS10 switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Provo, UT Tandem (PROVUTMA1GT Intra-Lata SHA/ PROVUTMA1GT Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Wendover, NV DMS10 switch and remotes, it will be retired and removed from the network.



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Provo, UT Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Wendover, NV DMS10, switch and remotes will be required to reposition the codes to the Provo, UT Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Provo, UT Tandem switch must be received no later than March 31, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by April 30, 2026. All ASRs for the Provo, UT Tandem switch must carry the project code of WNDVXCRL0.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Wendover, NV DMS10 switch.
