Description of Network Changes Planned:

FRONTIER NORTH INC. announces that it intends to retire its GTD-5 EAS Tandem switch in the wire center listed below:

On or after June 6, 2026, the Fort Wayne GTD-5 Tandem switch FTWYINXA15T will be retired and removed from the Frontier Network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network. All the NPA/NXX Codes subtending to the 11 Frontier and Carrier end offices (see Table B below) supporting Local/Intra-Lata traffic via the Fort Wayne FTWYINXA15T EAS tandem switch will be moved to the Fort Wayne IN 35T tandem switch (see details in Table A below). The codes will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the Fort Wayne IN FTWYINXA15T switch and will be reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Fort Wayne IN 35T Tandem switch. This will occur on or after June 6, 2026.



Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

The Fort Wayne IN 35T Tandem switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Fort Wayne IN 15T GTD-5 Tandem switch. Traffic bound for the end offices listed in Table B will be delivered via the Fort Wayne 35T Tandem (FTWYINXA35T). After all traffic is migrated off the Fort Wayne 15T Tandem switch, this switch will be retired and removed from the network.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the FTWYINXA35T Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Most, if not all, carriers already have trunking to the Fort Wayne IN 35T tandem that may be able to be utilized. Carriers that are code holders with connectivity in the Fort Wayne IN 15T tandem switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Fort Wayne 35T tandem.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the FTWYINXA35T Tandem switch must be received no later than May 6, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by June 6, 2026. All ASRs for the FTWYINXA35T Tandem switch must carry the project code of FTWYINXA15T.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Fort Wayne IN 15T Tandem switch.
