<b>Subject:</b>	Early Date Acceptance (EDA) Field Now Mandatory
<b>Date Effective:</b>	Immediately

Effective today, Frontier has made the EDA field mandatory on Access Service Requests (ASRs), as stated in notice [CCBFTR02358](#) on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The change impacts on all ASR products Frontier offers. The updates were implemented to improve overall service delivery and customer experience.

Admin	EDA	Early Date Acceptance	Must be populated with a “Y” = Early Acceptance Authorized or “N” = Early Acceptance Not Authorized

The change was implemented via the following Frontier Access Custom Business Rules.

- If the EDA field is left blank, the customer will receive a fatal error.
- Customer must populate the EDA field with an “N” if their Frame Due Time (FDT) field is populated.
- When a Purchase Order Number (PON) has an associated Related Purchase Order Number (RPON) populated, and there is a mismatch in the EDA field between the PON and RPON, the customer will receive a Clarification/Notification Request (C/NR).
