Description of Network Changes Planned:

FRONTIER NORTH, INC. - MI - announces that it intends to retire its DMS10 switch from the wire centers listed below:

<p>On or after October 31, 2026, the Woodland, MI DMS10 switch, will be retired and removed from the Frontier network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.</p> <p>The Exchange Codes (NXX) 269 in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 367 currently residing in the Woodland, MI DMS10 switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the MSKGMIXKPS0 PEO virtual switch (see details in Table A below).</p>		

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

The native NPA NXX belonging to the Woodland, MI DMS10 switch and associated remotes will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Muskegon, MI PEO switch. This will occur on or after October 31, 2026.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Muskegon, MI PEO switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Woodland, MI DMS10 switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Muskegon, MI Tandem (MSKGMIXK55T Intra-Lata SHA/ MSKGMIXK55T Inter-Lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Woodland, MI DMS10 switch and remotes, it will be retired and removed from the network.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes (cont.):

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Muskegon, MI Tandem or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunks (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Woodland, MI DMS10, switch and remotes will be required to reposition the codes to the Muskegon, MI Tandem switch.

All ASRs (Access Service Requests) for the Muskegon, MI Tandem switch must be received no later than September 30, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by October 31, 2026. All ASRs for the Muskegon, MI Tandem switch must carry the project code of WDLDMIXGRL0.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Woodland, MI DMS10 switch.
