Subject: ASR Submission Requirements for Ethernet Private Line (EPL)  
Connected to TLS NNI  
Date Effective: Immediately

Ethernet Private Line (EPL), formerly known as VzON, may connect from either a customer designated location (CDL) or collocation in one wire center or ride an Access Aggregation to another wire center where connection to a Transparent LAN Service (TLS) Network-to-Network Interface (NNI) port-only connection occurs.

To ensure billing accuracy, Frontier requires the submission of the TLS NNI and EPL ASRs in the following sequence:

1. First, submit TLS NNI ASR
2. Obtain TLS NNI Firm Order Confirmation (FOC)
3. Second, submit EPL ASR
  - a. If CDL to TLS NNI, CCEA field will be blank.
  - b. If collocation to TLS NNI, populate CCEA field with tie-down information.
  - c. If Access Aggregation to TLS NNI, populate CFA field with the Access Aggregation CFA.
  - d. For SECLOC location (TLS NNI), populate SCCEA field with the TLS NNI circuit ID.
4. If SCCEA field on EPL ASR does not contain the TLS NNI circuit ID to be connected to the requested EPL circuit then a clarification will be sent to populate SCCEA field with TLS NNI circuit ID.
